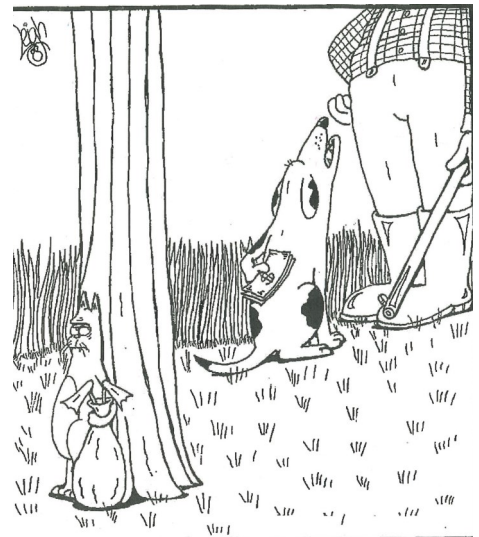


Of all the blonde jokes, this one has to be the best—because it makes football make sense!
