Winter league is now half over. Feels like it just got started!

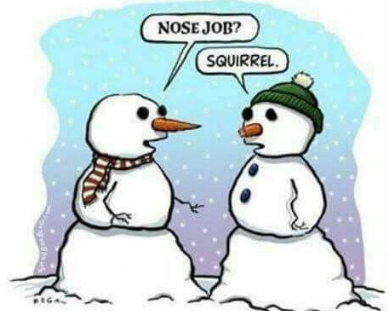

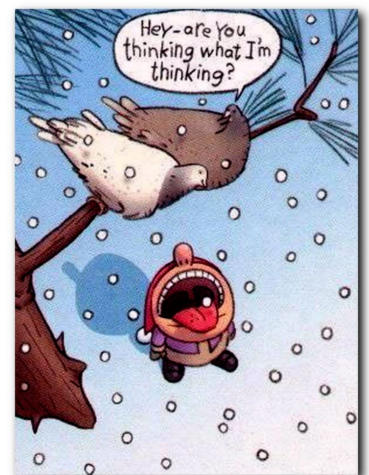
