News**

Well, it's March and the release fee on membership birds is \$3/bird + tax. Starting March 15th it is an additional \$3, so \$6/bird membership bird release.

ALL extra birds released are \$3/bird + tax.

We are doing what we can to eliminate this extra fee next year.

As of today, we have almost 2400 birds that need to be released by March 30. Problem...fields are booking fast for the rest of the month and those who wait too long will be out of luck.

There are no holding birds over until next season. Remember, we only guarantee your birds until March 9th so if you book a field from now until the end of March we will save your birds. If you wait until after the 9th and we don't have birds or fields available, we are sorry.

Extra birds after March 9th will be \$25 + tax. 1st come first served.

If you cannot make it out to hunt, and if you want Steve to clean up your remaining birds, you just

need to pay the March release fee and the cleaning fee. We can freeze them for you, but you need to pick them up by the end of March. We don't want them to get freezer burn! You must call by March 9th to make arrangements.

With the warm weather that we had there was a LOT of melting of the snow. Guess what?! Now there are a lot of slippery areas in the fields.

PLEASE GET YOURSELF A PAIR OF THOSE "GRIPPERS" THAT FIT ON YOUR BOOTS. IT MAY SAVE YOU FROM A NASTY FALL.
