PLEASE PAY WITH A CHECK OR CASH TO AVOID THE 3% CREDIT CARD FEE. We are trying so hard to keep all of our costs as low as possible to avoid raising fees any further, so we are good with a check. Sales tax is 5 1/2 %.

And remember that by paying in full before June 1st you will receive 1 round of sporting clays for each 10 birds paid. Great way to keep your shooting skills sharp. **Tickets will be kept at J&H to use when you come out to shoot. Just ask at the counter.** Saves us a stamp, thank you.

Last season we released 6100 pheasants. So far I have received renewals for only 1700...Our contract gets finalized the end of June and that is when I can add or subtract birds. Want those free rounds of

clays?...You must renew and pay in full by June 1st. May is 1/2 over so don't procrastinate...send your renewal to me today! I have only heard from 40 of the 140 members. Not good numbers by this time. I did send renewal forms by snail mail in April. I am also enclosing the renewal with this newsletter for those who misplaced that one.

Steve has been very busy in the fields. All are plowed, disked and fertilized, but not planted yet. And as I type this it is raining. Now he will have to wait for it to dry out again. It is early, so plenty of time.

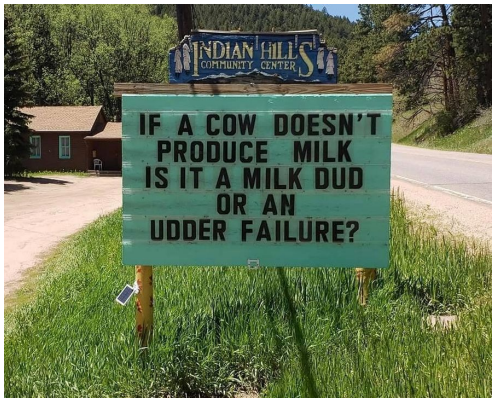
